Observation of Classes

Principal

This year we were no longer teaching online. All online classes were conducted only for a brief period in January 2023, when the DIOS closed the schools down due to the cold weather conditions. Children had to stay in class during the break under the supervision of the teachers. In the beginning the children found it difficult to concentrate for long periods of time, they were used to shorter periods of study. Now they had to submit handwritten work. At first getting the assignments back from the students proved rather difficult, getting them to write their unit tests was also difficult and many fared badly. Parents were called regularly for PTMs. Report cards were given for the Unit Tests, gradually they did better in the Half Yearly examinations. The classes were continuously observed by the Principal, the Vice Principal and the Senior HOD's. Slowly and steadily the students and teachers made progress, the students improved in the company of their friends, and under the constant guidance of their teachers. Children fared well in the Final examinations. The students of Classes IV and V had exams along with the senior classes. The senior classes had exams along with the CBSE Board Examination. The CBSE Boards Examinations were conducted and the school was a Centre for Spot Evaluation. The teachers had a very busy schedule, but rose to the challenges and did a good job.
